Abstract Format

Font: Times New Roman; Size: 12; Line spacing: 1.5 (Except affiliation - 1.0). Abstracts should have Title, Authors, Affiliation, Presenting author email, It should cover background, Objectives, Material and Methods, Results and Conclusion without subheading not exceeding 300 words (in MS WORD).

Mode of Presentation

- Keynote Address: Twenty minutes for power point presentation and 5 minutes for discussion.
- Lead Paper Presentation: Maximum fifteen minutes for power point presentation and three minutes for discussion.
- Abstract Presentation: All accepted abstracts are allowed for poster presentation. The dimension of poster should be 3ft (horizontal) × 4 ft (vertical).

Student Elocution

Students of SAUs/SVUs/Central Universities are eligible to apply for this program. The selected students will be given free accommodation. The students has to submit their research abstract for the conference. Students has to produce a certificate from their Dean/Head of the institute. The students will be given ten minutes time to deliver an extempore talk on the advances related to animal nutrition research.
