

Dairy Farmers Field day at Interior corner of Karnataka

The ICAR-National Institute of Animal Nutrition and Physiology, Bengaluru organized one day Farmers-Scientist Interaction meet cum Input Distribution on (21.03.2025) scientific feeding for dairy farmers, We reached to remote villages(Vengasandra, N.G Hulkur, Mustoor, Lakshmisagara, Kadiriganakoppa, Pooganahalli, Gennerahalli, Gandodihalli, etc) of K.G.F(Kolar Gold Fields) Taluk, Kolar Dt Karnataka and distributed Inputs (Rubber mat, Milk can, Fertimin plus powder, Ladies & school bags, Stationary kit, Veterinary medicinal kit, First aid kit) to selected SC Dairy farmers under Development Action Plan for Scheduled Caste (DAPSC). A total of 300 dairy farmers belonging to Scheduled caste benefitted in this program. This program is intended for educating farmers about scientific feeding of dairy animals.
