

Input Distribution at Farmers Door step and Animal Fertility camp under DAPSC Scheme

The ICAR-National Institute of Animal Nutrition and Physiology, Bengaluru organized one day Farmers-Scientist Interaction meet cum Input Distribution on (08.01.2025) scientific feeding for dairy farmers and distributed rubber mats to selected SC Dairy farmers of Kariyapanapalya, and villages nearby Ramohalli Benagluru South Karnataka under Development Action Plan for Scheduled Caste (DAPSC). A total of 100 dairy farmers belonging to Scheduled caste benefitted in this program. This program is intended for educating farmers to enhance hygienic and increased milk production and methods to prevent reproduction problems of dairy cows.
